*Six programs throughout the year will cover topics from container gardening to bats and owls*

*Lancaster, PA (April 3, 2019)* – On Saturday, May 4th, the Friends of the Tanger Arboretum will kick off their 2019 Nature Series. The Nature Series is a series of six, low-cost programs offered throughout 2019 that cover a variety of topics related to gardening and wildlife. This is the second time the Nature Series has been offered; the first of which was in 2018 and was greeted by the Lancaster County public with much success. "The goal of the Tanger Arboretum Nature series is to welcome adults and children of all ages to the Arboretum to learn from the insights of experts, and discover the fun, beauty, and diversity of nature," says Arboretum Board President Jeff Hazlett. "Plus you can learn skills to replicate at home, and involve your friends and family. Nature has that way of bringing people together."

### The 2019 line-up of programs include:

- ***Blooms & Birds*** on Saturday, May 4 at 10am
- ***Tips for Container Gardening*** on Saturday, June 1 at 10am
- ***Attracting Hummingbirds*** on Saturday, June 29 at 10am
- ***What's Not To Love About A Bluebird*** on Saturday, July 20 at 10am
- ***Creating Habitats for Butterflies*** on Saturday, August 24 at 10am

- ***Bats & Owls Under The Full Moon*** on Thursday, October 10 at 6:30pm

A majority of the programs will be led by Lisa Sanchez, Lancaster Central Park Naturalist, but will also feature guest presenters including Chris Abel (Lancaster County Master Gardener), Dr. Dean Rust (President of the Bluebird Society of Pennsylvania), and Deb Carman (York County Master Gardener).
