**Ackerman, Benjamin**

Born: October 20, 1852

Died: March 24, 1925 – buried at Mount Bethel Cemetery, Columbia, PA

- Listed at 121 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Columbia, in 1880

**Addis, John**

Born: c. 1827

Died: September 3, 1887, Richboro, Bucks County, PA

- Worked on North Queen Street above Penn Square, 1855 – 1857
- Possibly a brother of Robert Addis

**Addis, Robert W.**

Born: c. 1829

Died: c. 1873, Washington, DC

- Listed as an artist in the 1860 Census, Southeast Ward, Lancaster
- Possibly a brother of John Addis
- Later worked in Philadelphia

**Allen, Amos M.**

Born: March 31, 1823, Deerfield, Franklin County, MA

Died: July 1907, Pottsville, Schuylkill County, PA

- Had a studio at Locust and Front Streets, Columbia, from 1852 to 1894

**Aller, H. C.**

Born: March 26, 1841

Died: December 6, 1889, Trenton, NJ

- Aller's Gallery, 12 West King Street, 1887 – 1889
- See also William Amos, managed Aller's Gallery after H. C. Aller's death until 1891.

**Amos, William**

Born: March 1851, Maryland

Died: November 1, 1919

- Worked in Lancaster from 1885 to 1920
- Listed in 1880 Census in Chester, Delaware County, PA
- Manager of Lewis C. Fowler's Gallery, 12 West King Street in 1888
- May have worked briefly at 27 East King Street in 1885 or 1886
- Became proprietor of Aller's Gallery and Fulton Studio

**Andrews, Fannie K.**

Born: January 15, 1864, Strasburg, PA

Died: March 6, 1932, Sterling, Whiteside County, IL

- Daughter of Henry F. Andrews, jeweler in Strasburg, and sister of Jacob K. Andrews
- Jacob and Fannie opened a photo studio in their father's jewelry store on East Main Street in Strasburg
- Moved to Sterling, Illinois in 1912

**Andrews, Jacob K.**

Born: October 7, 1876, Strasburg, PA

Died: August 21, 1944, buried at Strasburg Cemetery

- Son of Henry F. Andrews, jeweler in Strasburg, and brother of Fannie K. Andrews
- Jacob and Fannie opened a photo studio in their father's jewelry store on East Main Street in Strasburg
- Also worked at Bridge Street, opposite Gay Street, in Christiana, 1905 – 1910

**Apperly, Richard**

Born: March 1852, England

Died: September 11, 1909, Bart Township, Lancaster County, PA

- Listed at 501 Love Lane (now Fairview Avenue), Lancaster, 1894 – 1898

**Auxer, George H.**

Born: c. 1825, Chambersburg, PA

Died: before 1870

- Worked in Marietta at Elbow Lane near Front Street, 1859 – 1860
- Also worked in Chambersburg and Lewistown, PA and Hackettstown, NJ

**Bailey, William**

Born: November 15, 1853, Tamaqua, Schuylkill County, PA

Died: February 25, 1937, Columbia, PA, buried at Mount Bethel Cemetery

- Listed at 36 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Columbia, 1887 – 1914
- Son, Herbert (b. 1880), also worked as a photographer

**Ball, Ella**

Born: 1869

Died: March 19, 1952

- Listed in 1890 Lancaster City & County Directory as “artist”
- Listed in 1892 Lancaster City & County Directory as “retoucher”
- Lived and worked at 119 College Avenue, Lancaster, 1897 – 1940
- Moved to 902 New Holland Avenue, Lancaster

**Banks, William S.**

Born: c. 1881, England

Died: ?

- Listed at 149 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1909 – 1910
- Possibly worked as a school teacher
- Married Mary E. Wenger and moved to Toledo, Ohio, c. 1915
- Became an Episcopal minister

**Bauman, B.**

Born: c. 1817

- Possibly Benjman Bauman

- Amateur photographer
- Lived at 526 South Queen Street, listed there in 1880 Census

**Bealler, Earl H.**

Born: October 24, 1889

Died: November 30, 1916

- Listed at 744 South Lime Street, Lancaster, 1913 – 1916

**Beam, Daniel C.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Ephrata, c. 1884

**Bear, John**

Born: January 3, 1797, Lancaster

Died: November 6, 1858, Lancaster

- Known primarily as a printer, but also worked in photography in the 1840s and 1850s

**Bechtel, Jacob**

Born: February 15, 1858, Pennsylvania

Died: December 18, 1937 – buried at Swamp Church, West Cocalico Township.

- In Blainsport, West Cocalico Twp., in 1900
- Listed as a printer in Ephrata in 1910

**Bemensderfer, John K.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed as a crayon artist on South Prussian Street in Manheim in 1890

**Benson, Charles H.**

Born: c. 1829

Died: August 10, 1902, Philadelphia

- In business with J. Miles Jamison as Jamison & Benson, 80 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1864 – 1866
- Listed in Philadelphia in 1870, 1880, and 1900 Census

**Berner, Louis**

Born: c. 1839, Prussia

Died: before 1901?

- Lived at 451 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, in 1880, next door to his brother, Otto Berner, and Howard H. Betz, another photographer
- May have worked as a gilder and upholsterer
- In business with Jonathan Good as Good & Berner Bros., 1873

**Berner, Otto**

Born: July 1840, Prussia

Died: June 21, 1901, Lancaster, buried at Greenwood Cemetery

- Lived at 449 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, in 1880, next door to his brother, Louis Berner, and Howard H. Betz, another photographer
- Worked as a gilder and picture framer
- In business with Jonathan Good as Good & Berner Bros., 1873
- Listed as a gilder in the 1900 Census

**Betz, Howard H.**

Born: c. 1846

Died: November 8, 1892, Philadelphia

- Lived at 501 West Chestnut Street, Lancaster, in 1880
- In business with George H. Richards as Betz & Richards in 1884
- Also worked at 43½ North Queen Street, 1884 – 1886
- See also George H. Richards

**Bew, George**

Born: June 22, 1835, Virginia

Died: July 2, 1913 – buried at Mount Bethel Cemetery, Columbia, PA

- Had Broad Street Gallery in Lititz, 1890 – 1896
- At 162 Locust Street, Columbia, 1900 – 1914

**Bishop, Simon Good**

Born: March 27, 1870

Died: December 10, 1955, Elizabethtown, buried at Mount Tunnel Cemetery

- Had studio at 11 North Market Street, Elizabethtown, 1909 – 1930

**Black, Adam**

Born: c. 1855, New York

Died: ?

- Listed in Paradise Twp. in 1880 Census with family of James Harding

**Black, Harry A.**

Born: c. 1859

Died: March 16, 1895

- Had Black's Studio, 24 West King Street, Lancaster, 1886 – 1900
- Took over both L. C. Fowler's and H. C. Aller's studios
- Studied with William Gill

**Bonine, Archie F.**

Born: April 9, 1846

Died: August 31, 1907, Lancaster

- Listed as a tinsmith in the 1880 and 1900 Census
- Worked at 445 South Queen Street, 1884 – 1892
- Also listed as Reading & Bonine with John T. Reading
- Brother of Robert A. and Elias Bonine Jr.

**Bonine, Elias Jr.**

Born: September 20, 1843

Died: August 7, 1916, Pasadena, California

- Moved first to Altoona, PA
- In Mendocino County, California by 1880
- In Los Angeles, CA, by 1892
- Brother of Archie F. and Robert A. Bonine

**Bonine, Robert A.**

Born: December 11, 1836

Died: October 26, 1912, Altoona, PA

- Worked primarily in Altoona, PA, and Hollidaysburg, PA
- Brother of Archie F. and Elias Bonine Jr.

**Bowers, William Daniel**

Born: February 23, 1884

Died: February 2, 1950, Lancaster, buried at Cedar Lawn Cemetery

- Lived and worked at 131 East New Street, Lancaster, 1915 – 1933

**Boyd, Walter M.**

Born: c. 1860, New York

Died: ?

- Listed at 115 East King Street, Lancaster, in 1880 Census
- Also had Walter M. Boyd & Co. in Philadelphia

**Brown, E. B.**

Born: ?

Died: ?



- Worked in Lititz

**Buchholz, Joseph**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Lititz

**Campion, J. W. H.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Corner of Queen and Orange Streets, Lancaster, 1880s

**Combs, Jacob**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Safe Harbor, Conestoga Twp., 1859 – 1860

**Cook, William T.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed at 210 Locust Street, Columbia, 1892

**Cooper, P. F.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- In Lancaster County c. 1869

**Couch's Art Studio**

- In Mount Joy, 1914

**Cummings, George Byron**

Born: 1856

Died: August 13, 1934, Lancaster

- Son of Thomas Cummings

- Worked at 6 North Queen Street and 106 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1875 – 1888

### **Cummings, Eli**

Born: c. 1825, Marietta

Died: September 7, 1892, Lancaster, buried at Lancaster Cemetery

- Brother of Thomas Cummings
- Worked in Marietta and Mount Joy, c. 1860
- Later moved to Lancaster with his brother

### **Cummings, Thomas**

Born: January 12, 1827, Marietta

Died: July 1, 1887, Lancaster

- First to use ambrotype/collodian process commercially in Lancaster
- Had studios at 21 North Queen Street and 40 North Queen Street, 1857 – 1886

### **Cummings, William**

Born: c. 1815, Marietta

Died: January 19, 1881, Lancaster

- Brother of Thomas Cummings
- Worked briefly in Lancaster, 1857 – 1860

### **Damant, James**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked with Dr. William B. Fahnestock in Lancaster in the 1840s
- Listed as Fahnestock & Damant in 1842
- Possibly lived later in Williamsport, PA

### **Darmstaetter's Photo Supply House**

- Established as Lancaster Photo Supply House
- Bought by Jacob Darmstaetter in 1905
- Eventually became a small department and stationery store
- Closed c. 1976

### **Dellinger, Samuel L.**

Born: April 18, 1828

Died: March 8, 1897, buried at Marietta Cemetery

- Worked at 65 North Market Street, Marietta, 1859 – 1896
- Also worked as a harness maker and saddler



**Dellinger, John**

Born: c. 1829

Died: November 2, 1865, Lancaster

- Listed in Lancaster at the northwest corner of Penn Square near the market, 1854 – 1860
- Listed in Lancaster, Southeast Ward, in 1860 Census

**Demmy, Aaron**

Born: January 1, 1850

Died: September 25, 1923, Elizabethtown

- Lived and worked in Elizabethtown, 1914 – 1920

**Demuth, Ferdinand**

Born: March 22, 1857, Lancaster

Died: January 27, 1811, buried at Lancaster Cemetery

- Owner of Demuth's Tobacco Shop on East King Street, Lancaster
- Member of the Lancaster Camera Club
- Father of artist Charles Demuth
- Listed as a photographer from 1894 – 1910

**Dengler, Ignatius J.**

Born: November 28, 1871, Germany

Died: August 21, 1928, Lancaster, PA, buried at St. Mary's Cemetery

- Worked as assistant to Otto Weber
- Listed at 22 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1896 – 1910

**Denlinger, Walter M.**

Born: December 2, 1892

Died: July 21, 1930, Erie, PA, buried in Lancaster, PA

- Listed at 10 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1913 – 1914
- Death certificate listed his occupation as "actor"

**Dobson, W.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Possibly the William Dobson listed in Manheim in the 1860 Census



**Dornmeyer, John**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed in Lancaster in 1857

**Dunn, J. G.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Lancaster?

**Eberman, Albert**

Born: June 20, 1841, Lancaster

Died: March 16, 1867, Lancaster

- Son of Peter Eberman and brother of Charles W. Eberman
- Partner of Jacob Stehman – Eberman & Stehman
- Listed at 28 East King Street, Lancaster, from 1863 – 1867
- Also listed as Abner Eberman

**Eberman, Charles W.**

Born: November 2, 1833, Lancaster

Died: April 18, 1866, Lancaster

- Son of Peter Eberman and brother of Albert Eberman
- Listed at 28 East King Street, Lancaster, from 1863 – 1866

**Eberman, Peter**

Born: November 13, 1795, Lancaster

Died: May 4, 1879, Lancaster

- Father of Albert and Charles W. Eberman
- Primarily a tobacconist, but may also have worked as a photographer
- Listed at 28 East King Street, Lancaster, from 1863 – 1869

**Ehrman, Michael**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Lancaster, c. 1860





**Ehrmann, Charles**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Possibly in Lancaster, c. 1856
- Also listed in Philadelphia, 1849 – 1860
- Possibly also a physician

**Engle, Horace M.**

Born: February 23, 1861

Died: February 26, 1949, Easton, PA, buried at Maytown, PA

- From Marietta
- Known for work with buttonhole camera
- Large collection of his work is at the Pennsylvania State Archives in Harrisburg, PA

**Ensminger, Samuel A.**

Born: June 24, 1827

Died: November 8, 1909, Manheim

- Listed as Ensminger & Co., Manheim, 1864 – 1866
- Listed as Ensminger & Miller, with Warren Miller, Manheim, 1884
- Listed at 9 North Prussian Street, Manheim, 1875 – 1886

**Ensminger, Charles A.**

Born: July 19, 1866, Manheim

Died: April 13, 1921, Manheim

- Son of Samuel A. Ensminger
- Also worked at 9 North Prussian Street
- Also worked as a pharmacist

**Eppler, Charles E.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Worked in Columbia, c. 1850

**Ernst, Frederick**

Born: February 1870

Died: March 1, 1932, Lancaster

- Worked at 15½ East King Street and 11 East King Street, Lancaster, 1890 – 1925
- Also had Keystone Studio at 149 North Queen Street, Lancaster

**Erskine, J. B.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed at Simpson's Building, Market Square, Elizabethtown, 1864 – 1866
- Also worked in Sunbury, PA

**Face, Jesse**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- May have worked in Beartown, Caernarvon Twp., 1859 – 1860

**Fahnestock, William Baker**

Born: October 13, 1804, Lancaster

Died: April 27, 1886, Lancaster

- Was also a physician
- Worked with James Damant, Damant & Fahnestock, in the 1840s

**Ferree, Oden Orville**

Born: March 6, 1889, Paradise Twp., York County

Died: January 12, 1960, York, PA, buried at Altland Meeting House, Paradise Twp., York County

- Worked as a photographer in Ephrata during the 1920s
- Moved back to York by 1930
- Later worked for Meldrum & Landis Glass Co. in York

**Fisher, A. H.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed in 1884 and 1886 City and County Directories in Ephrata Twp.
- May have worked later as a cigar packer

**Fitzgerald, Charles D.**

Born: 1885

Died: March 4, 1948, Lancaster

- Lived at 319 West Walnut Street, Lancaster
- Listed as a photographer in Lancaster, 1908 – 1918

**Flick, George**

Born: c. 1822

Died: February 22, 1897, Lancaster

- Lived at 15 West German Street, Lancaster
- Listed as an outdoor photographer, 1875 – 1876
- Also worked as a taxidermist

**Fordney, James G.**

Born: September 12, 1818

Died: September 28, 1886, Lancaster

- Listed in Elizabethtown in 1850 Census
- Listed in Lancaster in 1860 Census
- Also spelled Fortney

**Fowler, Lewis C.**

Born: July 29, 1860, New Jersey

Died: August 26, 1906, buried at Eglington Cemetery, Clarksboro, Burlington County, NJ

- Worked at 12 West King Street, Lancaster, 1884 – 1886
- This studio became Aller's Gallery in 1887
- Listed at 38 – 40 West King Street, Lancaster, c. 1890
- Later worked in Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ

**Fox, Christian**

Born: May 20, 1846

Died: March 21, 1918, Parkesburg, Chester County, PA

- Worked in Gap, Salisbury Twp., 1890 – 1892
- Listed as a housepainter in the 1900 Census

**Freehaffer, Franklin**

Born: January 13, 1849

Died: January 23, 1917, buried at Muddy Creek Cemetery, Reamstown, PA

- Worked in Adamstown, 1880 – c. 1900
- Listed as a carriage painter in 1900 Census
- Also spelled Freehoefer, Freehaefer

**Fritz, Edwin R.**

Born: February 22, 1891, Akron, PA

Died: June 19, 1947, buried at Cedar Lawn Cemetery, Ephrata, PA

- Amateur photographer
- Lived in Akron borough
- Photographer for U. S. Navy at time of his death

**Gill, William L.**

Born: January 18, 1827

Died: December 14, 1893, Lancaster

- Gill's City Gallery, 20 East King Street and later 19 East King Street, Lancaster, 1859 – 1882

**Gerhard, Jacob G.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- Listed at 15½ East King Street, Lancaster, 1903 – 1906

**Good, Jonathan**

Born: c. 1834?

Died: ?

- Possibly the Jno. P. Good listed as County Recorder in Lancaster in the 1880 Census
- Also listed as Good & Berner Bros. in 1873
- Listed at 80 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1869 – 1870

**Hackman, Benjamin**

Born: 1858

Died: ?

- Listed in the 1880 Census in Mount Joy

**Hallacher, Adam**

Born: June 23, 1823

Died: June 12, 1910, buried at Zion United Methodist Cemetery, Akron, PA

- Lived in Rothsville, Warwick Twp.
- Possibly had a dry goods store
- Saloon keeper in 1880 Census

### **Harmany, Alfred**

Born: c. 1836

Died: August 13, 1875, Lancaster

- Worked as clerk at Return E. Fahnestock's dry goods store, c. 1860
- Listed as Harmany & Eberman at 37 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1863 – 1864, and at 35½ North Queen Street, 1866 – 1867
- Listed by himself from 1868 – 1873
- Listed as "coloring agent" in 1875 – 1876 Lancaster Directory

### **Harpel, Morris S.**

Born: October 21, 1881, Lancaster

Died: October 14, 1916

- Listed at 16 East King Street, Lancaster, 1907 – 1912
- Also worked in Lebanon

### **Heiss, William H.**

Born: c. 1840

Died: before 1880

- Worked in Strasburg and New Holland, c. 1864 – 1866
- Worked in Philadelphia, c. 1866
- Worked in Tremont, Schuylkill County, c. 1870

### **Hennis, William T.**

Born: ?

Died: ?

- In business with James S. Saurmann as Saurmann & Hennis, 43 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1875 – 1876

### **Hess, Christian**

Born: June 18, 1861, Lancaster

Died: March 5, 1935, Lancaster, buried at Millersville Mennonite Cemetery

- Listed in Lancaster Twp. in 1880

### **Hess, Joseph**

Born: February 21, 1844

Died: March 5, 1927, New Bloomfield, Perry County, PA

- Listed in Mifflintown, Juniata County in 1880 Census
- Lived at 20 North Shippen Street, Lancaster in 1900 Census
- Worked at 50 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1901 – 1910

### **Hippard, E.**

- Worked in Elizabethtown c. 1870
- Possibly Emanuel Hippard, born in 1845, son of John and Elizabeth Hippard.
- May have lived in Elizabethtown in the late 1860s
- Listed in Annville, Lebanon County, in the 1870 Census

### **Hoak & Helm**

- Possibly Jacob and Frank Hoak, father and son, owned a dry goods store in Strasburg
- Also Hoak & Johnson
- Worked during 1860s
- Helm may be Franklin Helm, dry goods merchant in Providence Township in 1870

### **Hoffman, Jacob**

Born: c. 1823

Died: ?

- Worked in Strasburg during the 1850s, possibly 1860s

### **Holton, Henry H.**

Born: c. 1853

Died: September 5, 1888, Lancaster

- Lived at 52 West Orange Street, Lancaster, in 1880
- Worked as a painter
- In business with William H. Inman as Holton & Inman

### **Hosten, Charles**

Born: February 1850

Died ?

- Listed at 6 North Queen Street, Lancaster, in 1880
- Hotelkeeper at 125 North Queen Street, Lancaster, in 1900
- Walter Miesse, photographer, is living next door in 1900

**Hubley, John W.**

Born: 1848, Lancaster

Died: September 19, 1888, Lancaster

- Worked at 45 West King Street and 45 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1866 – 1888



**Hyers, George A.**

Born: c. 1842

Died: ?

- Listed at Front Street, Columbia, 1864 – 1866
- In Philadelphia in 1870 Census, listed as a “travelling agent”

**Ideal Photograph Company**

- 149 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1907 – 1908
- See also William S. Banks

**Inman, William H.**

Born: February 10, 1844

Died: April 6, 1932, Upper Darby, PA

- Listed at 522 East Orange Street, Lancaster, in 1880 Census
- In business with Henry H. Holton as Holton & Inman
- 1883 Lancaster business directory, p. 70: at 43 ½ N. Queen Street
- In Philadelphia in 1900 Census

**Ishler, Harman**

Born: September 1, 1845

Died: January 5, 1935, Elizabethtown, PA – buried at Mount Tunnel Cemetery

- Listed in Elizabethtown in 1898
- Cigar manufacturer in 1900

**Jameson, Charles**

Born: c. 1827

Died: before 1880

- Worked in Columbia, possibly had a studio on Front Street
- Listed as an ambrotype artists in the 1860 Census, Loganville, York County
- Also worked in Harrisburg, 1864 – 1875

**Jamison, J. Miles**

Born: November 1, 1844

Died: February 5, 1911, Richboro, Bucks County, PA

- In business with C. H. Benson as Jamison & Benson, 80 North Queen Street, Lancaster, 1864 – 1866
- Listed on his own in Lancaster, 1868 – 1869



**Johnston, Charles M.**

Born: c. 1811

Died: September 5, 1864, Lancaster County

- Listed as an artist in Drumore Twp. in the 1850 Census
- In business with John M. Johnston in Lancaster at Mechanics Hall on South Queen Street and also at the corner of North Queen and Orange Streets
