HISTORY

The Louise Arnold Tanger Arboretum (pronounced "tan'-jer") on the grounds of LancasterHistory was designed by Gustaf Malmborg of Manheim, PA. When the Willson Memorial Building was constructed in 1956, neighbor and naturalist Louise Arnold Tanger offered to plant trees on the barren grounds surrounding the building. Mrs. Tanger joined the Board of then Lancaster County Historical Society, now LancasterHistory, where she took charge of the grounds until her death in 1959. Her son Charles took her place and served as the historical society's naturalist for many years until his death in 1991. Following Charles Tanger's death, the Board established a group known as The Friends of the Tanger Arboretum to care for the Arboretum.

TOURS

EDUCATION & EVENTS

HOURS

The Tanger Arboretum is open from dawn to dusk to the public. Arboretum and Conifer Garden maps are available at Visitor Services inside the museum. They are also available in boxes attached to Tanger Arboretum signs near the Pollinator Garden and Conifer Garden areas.

There is no admission fee, however, donations are welcome and membership is encouraged.

ACCESSIBILITY

Much of the Arboretum is accessible via wheelchair- accessible pathways. There are multiple accessible parking spaces in front of LancasterHistory. The building also provides accessible entrances and bathrooms.

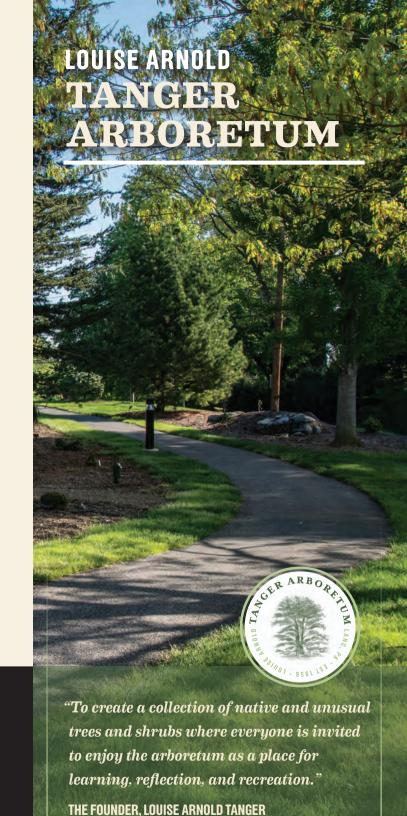
VOLUNTEER
