# Discover the Secrets of Bluebird Conservation at Tanger Arboretum Event

Join Dr. Dean Rust on June 15 for an Expert-Led Informational Session on Caring for Backyard

Eastern Bluebirds

**LANCASTER, PA** — Join the Friends of the Tanger Arboretum on Saturday, June 15 at 10am for "The Ecology & Management of the Eastern Bluebird." Dr. Dean Rust, President of the Bluebird Society of Pennsylvania, will share his expertise in becoming a skilled caretaker of backyard Bluebirds.

Attendees will gain valuable knowledge about installing and monitoring nest boxes and will learn about the life cycle of Bluebirds from nest building to fledgling. This educational session promises to be a must-attend for Bluebird enthusiasts and anyone interested in bird conservation efforts.

Dr. Dean Rust has been the President of the Bluebird Society of Pennsylvania since 2012. He oversees 22 Bluebird trails, monitors over 450 nest boxes, and helps fledge over 1,000 Bluebirds each summer. Rust is the author of *The Beloved and Charismatic Bluebird*, a comprehensive guide offering practical advice for backyard birders. resident, practiced general dentistry until 2005 and served as a field hockey umpire in the Lancaster area for 20 years.
