THE VALENTINE'S GALA

The Valentine's Gala has quickly become one of the community's most sought after social events. LIVING HISTORY AT WHEATLAND

Our monthly Living History programs bring visitors into contact with President James Buchanan, his family, and other Lancastrians from centuries past. During this series of interactive performance-based tours, actors provide compelling interactive stories in Buchanan's beloved home, Wheatland. Month after month, Living History tours sell out to audiences composed of locals of all ages and of visitors to the area, many of whom come to Lancaster just for the chance to participate in our program of the month. Visitors are all ages, and frequently are family groups.

"PAY WHAT YOU CAN" SATURDAYS

As an educational institution, we are dedicated to providing access to our shared history for all citizens of Lancaster County. Tours of President Buchanan's Wheatland provide access to the home of Pennsylvania's only United States President, while exhibitions such as FREEDOM: *"to secure the Blessings of Liberty"* explore the stories of Lancastrians who sought freedom, fought for freedom, lived in freedom, or were denied freedom over the course of 300 years. In an effort to share these transformative and inspiring stories with all of our community, we are poised to offer "Pay What You Can" Saturdays beginning August 2017. Become a "Pay What You Can" sponsor today and provide free access to low-income visitors from around Lancaster County.

Each August, we celebrate the hard work and dedication of our volunteers with a picnic and prizes at the Conestoga House & Gardens.

REGIONAL HISTORY COLLOQUIUM

One of the most-loved and well-attended programs we offer is LancasterHistory.org's Regional History Colloquia Series, a year-round series of hour-long presentations by historians, published authors, and other scholars who are researching an area of interest or completing a publication related to the history of the county and Southeastern Pennsylvania. We host one colloquium per month, preceded by a social reception, ten months of the year (we typically do not host one in July and August). This program attracts an audience of adult learners.
